Agenda Item: WWTP#1 Electrical Disconnect and Rewire Consideration.

Explanation: Power will need to be disconnected from the Control Building, at Wastewater Treatment Plant #1, before it can be demoed. Power will need to be rewired and ran to the Public Works Equipment Storage Building. Staff received one quote so far but has contacted two companies.

Fiscal Impact: Not to exceed \$20,000.00 for the Electrical Disconnect and Rewire of the Equipment Storage Building. There are sufficient funds in the Buildings Maintenance Account.

Committee Discussion: The Equipment Storage building will need power for lights, equipment, and heat. This building will be used for the foreseeable future as a Public Works Equipment Storage Building. Staff recommends allowing up to \$20,000.00, not-to-exceed, for any unforeseen issues that were not quoted.

Action Requested: Motion to move payment authorization to perform the Electrical Disconnect and Rewire of the Public Works Equipment Storage Building in a not-to-exceed amount \$20,000.00 to tonight's City Council Agenda.
