Agenda Item: Bid Award – Felkers Drainage Improvement

Explanation: Staff solicited bids for the drainage priority project U which is the drainage improvements in the Felkers Subdivision. This project will include the placement of yard inlets to better direct the water to the storm sewer as well as upsizing the current culvert that drains a large section of the subdivision.

A bid opening took place on May 14, 2024 at 10 AM at City Hall with two bids submitted.

Company	Bid Amount
Knapp Concrete	\$ 419,975.00
JC Dillon	\$ 448,291.00
Engineers Estimate	\$278,554.44

The engineers estimate was from 2022/2023 during the Drainage Priority Project Study. An update was not done during the final design. Cost was higher due to the location of the pipe near basement foundations and a shed.

Fiscal Impact: The FY 24-25 budget includes \$500,000 in the General Stormwater Management Fund for Capital Stormwater projects.

Recommendation Summary: Staff recommends the approval of a contract award for the Felkers Drainage Improvement Project for the amount of \$ 419,975.00 to Knapp Concrete out of Goodfield, IL
