Agenda Item: Payment Authorization – Well #11 Emergency Repair

Explanation: Council may recall Well #11 had a motor failure in late March of this year. It was recommended to replace the failed motor, a 20-year-old pump, column pipe that was worn/pitted and wire that was undersized for today's standards. Completing these recommendations will help ensure the well runs for the foreseeable future with little to no issues. Well 11 & 12 have been in service since the early 2000s servicing Water Treatment Plant #2. This is the first major issue/rehab the City has had with either of these wells.

Fiscal Impact: \$86,939.00 for all emergency repairs and labor. Water Fund - 500-000-800-3000

Recommendation: Payment authorization for the Well #11 emergency repairs. Staff will monitor the budget and delay projects and/or purchases when able. Staff wants to make Council aware there may need to be a budget amendment at the end of the year, depending on where the budget lands.

Action Requested: Approve Payment Authorization to Chris Ebert Company for Well #11 emergency repairs in the amount of \$86,393.00 as part of the Consent Agenda.
