



GENERAL SERVICE GUIDELINES

One 65-gallon or 95-gallon roller-cart is included in your monthly fee.

Please have your garbage and recycling at the curb **before 6:00 a.m. on your collection day.**

Private containers and garbage bags can be set out in addition to the material in your roller-cart. Private garbage containers and garbage bags are limited to 35-gallon in size and must weigh less than 50 pounds per unit.

Unacceptable items:

- ⊗ E-Waste
- ⊗ Concrete, Rocks, or Dirt
- ⊗ Paint (liquid form)
- ⊗ Hazardous Waste
- ⊗ Tires
- ⊗ Yard Waste
- ⊗ Car Parts
- ⊗ Construction Debris

SERVICE OPTIONS

You must sign up for recycling. There is no additional fee to recycle.

Additional Garbage or Recycling Carts

You can rent a second 65-gallon or 95-gallon sturdy, easy to use roller-cart for \$2.50 per cart per month, paid quarterly in advance for additional carts. Contact us to learn more.

Bulk Items

Households may dispose of bulk items during weekly service for a fee. You must call or email the office to schedule a pick up. The fee is \$15 per item.

Items include:

- Tables and chairs
- Mattresses and box springs

Please wrap any couches, mattresses and carpet securely in plastic for pick up. If an item is saturated with water due to weather, our driver will be unable to take the item until it is dry.

YARD WASTE

Weekly yard waste collection at the curb is an optional service available on an annual subscription basis.

Yard waste collection will be weekly on Fridays throughout the City from April through November.

Extra volume beyond the cart needs to be properly set out:

- All material needs to be in a brown paper yard waste bag.
- All bundled yard waste must be less than 4 feet in length.
- Please tie bundles with non-metallic cord, such as twine

E- Waste

E-waste drop-off is free. Please note that a proper form of identification is required for the drop-off. Households must have GFL accounts in good standing to use the drop-off.

Billing

OBSERVED HOLIDAYS

If a holiday falls on a weekday before or on your normal service day, garbage, recycling, and yard waste collection will be delayed by one day.

If the holiday falls on a weekend, services will not be delayed.

RECYCLING GUIDELINES



Metal and Aluminum Cans

Aluminum, steel, and tin cans. Do not crush cans.



Cardboard and Mixed Paper

All mixed paper and cardboard. Breakdown all boxes.



Plastic #1 and #2

Plastic tub, jugs, jars, and bottles. Put the cap/lids back on.
