WEED SPRAYING SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. All bids must be submitted on the BID PROPOSAL provided by the city, fully completed, signed and dated by the bidder.
- 2. Bidders are required to bid on each and every lot/parcel/right-of-way identified on the Bid Form.
- 3. Each bid must include the submission of the following:
 - a. BID PROPOSAL
 - b. CLIENT LISTING FORM
 - c. EQUIPMENT LISTING FORM
- 4. Bidder must inspect each work location, in advance of submitting a bid, to become familiar with the site(s) and working conditions.
- 5. Spraying shall be performed in the manner and frequency indicated on the Bid Form.
- 6. "Right-of-way" is defined as "back of curb to back of curb", and includes the pavement, curb and the joint between the curb and sidewalk in those areas where sidewalks are immediately adjacent to the curb. Bidder shall achieve a complete kill of all vegetation within the right-of-way at the time of spraying. If complete kill is not achieved, bidder shall re-treat all areas where complete kill has not been achieved at no additional cost. Bidder shall use carrier of crop oil or similar material and systematic, non-selective herbicide. Full details regarding the specific chemicals to be used shall be provided to and approved by the city prior to application.
- 7. The successful bidder shall commence work within ten (10) days of notification to start and shall complete all specified work within 14 calendar days after start.
- 8. The successful bidder must comply with all Illinois Department of Agriculture pesticide/herbicide regulations.
- 9. The successful bidder will be required to submit an invoice for services indicating the following: the date(s) each individual lot/parcel/right-of-way was treated, the price per each treatment as per bid, the total amount(s) due per each individual parcel/tract/right-of-way and the grand total amount due for all completed spraying. The City reserves the right to adjust quantities as required to fit actual field conditions. Adjustments will be made from the bid quantity and price to establish a unit price for each item of adjustment, up or down as directed.
- 10. Bidder must provide evidence of insurance as follows: Combined Single Limit (bodily injury and property damage): \$1,000,000. City to be named as additional insured.
- 11. Bidder must comply with Workers Compensation Insurance requirements as provided by law.
